There are a few things I do need from you or your Healthy Church Team:

- 1. I need plans for all of your events sent to me two weeks in advance of the date the event is to take place. As the pandemic worsens and cases in our area spike, I want to look at these plans so I can approve them.
- 2. If you are planning Christmas Eve worship, it may be likely that you need to double down, especially on registrations for worship. Six-foot social distancing is still required, and maintaining this may necessitate a second or even a third Christmas Eve service.
- 3. Remember that the November 13 amendment to Governor Northam's Executive Order 67 limits non-worship gatherings to 25 persons in attendance, so make sure you are abiding by that as you plan and execute your upcoming events.
- 4. If you suspect that a person in your church has been exposed to COVID or has tested positive, you must let me know immediately.

Again, I thank you all for all you are doing to be the church, even now, and I give thanks to all of the creative and meaningful ways you are retelling and revealing the story of the One born in Bethlehem for nothing less than the salvation of the world. Thank you all for being such purveyors of hope, light, and life.
